In case you had concerns, here are some frequently asked questions and answers to clear things up.

#### WHERE DO WE PUT THE TRASH?

The trash bins are located in our neighbor's yard to the left of the house behind the white, single bay garage/shed. The gray bins are for trash and the green and blue bins are for recycling. If you have trouble locating the bins you may leave the trash sealed in bags on the porch and we will dispose of them upon your departure.

#### I HAVE MOBILITY ISSUES/TROUBLE CLIMBING STAIRS

There are several stairs to get to and from the seaside suite. If you have mobility issues please let us know prior to arrival and we will arrange to have ground level parkng for you.

#### I AM TRAVELING WITH AN INFANT. DO YOU HAVE A CRIB AND HIGHCHAIR?

There is a pack and play and a high chair in the bedroom closet. There are also beach toys, baby float and a kiddie pool available for use in the laundry room.

#### CAN WE USE THE BIKES AND KAYAKS?

You are welcome to use the bikes and kayaks free of charge. You must use a

helmet and life jackets during use. Kayaking without a life jacket is a fineable offense in Warwick. Prior to using bikes and kayaks you must complete a liability release form located in the wooden chest in the living room. Please let us known if you would like to use the kayaks and we will provide you with a paddle. If a paddle is misplaced you will be charge a \$25 replacement fee. In addition you may rent fishing rods for \$20/day. If fishing rods are damaged or lost you will be charged a \$50 replacement fee. There is a bate shop located in the neighborhood, within walking distance from the cottage.



## HISTORY OF THE COTTAGE



Magical Midgley is a historic seaside cottage that was built in 1914 by the Higgins Family.

Directed by their family doctor, The Higgins Family moved their young son, John to the sea for the salt air to heal his lungs of whooping cough. John Higgin's health improved and at five years old his mother threw him into the bay to learn how to swim! John grew up and went on to compete and win in the 1936 Summer Olympics and set two world records in 1935 and 1936 for swimming. During his career John Higgins won 11 national titles and set 10 world records in breaststroke and medley events and in

#### 1971 he was inducted into the International Swimming Hall of Fame! He later went on to teach swimming and diving to the Navy.
